Prof. Carlos Rocha G. (Visuddha-Sattva dasa) is a Mathematician (UCV-Caracas, Venezuela), indologist, author of several books, translator and publishing manager. Born in Spain in 1945, he has lived in Venezuela, Paris, London, California and India, where he has participated in many academic events and international conferences. He is original trustee of The Bhaktivedanta Institute and Regional Director for Latin America, Spain & Europe, Miami, and Vrindavana, India, where he has lectured on

Vedic Cosmology, one of his main research subject matters. He is the disciple of A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada, the Founder-Acharya of the Bhaktivedanta Institute and ISKCON.
